### Planned Parenthood Exposed

Abby Johnson mesmerized Evening for Life guests with the story of her work as an ambitious executive director for a growing Planned Parenthood in Bryan, TX.

"I had never seen an abortion happen on an ultrasound," she said. "My job during the procedure was to hold the probe on the woman's abdomen. I could see the whole profile of the baby 13 weeks head to foot. I could see the whole side profile. I could see the probe. I could see the baby try to move away from the probe."

Abby then realized that she and her husband had received an ultrasound picture of their daughter at the same age as this baby. She watched the baby "crumple" as it was vacuumed out of a patient's uterus.

"I just thought, 'What am I doing?'" she said. "And then I thought, 'Never again.' I looked out the window and saw a couple of women praying and I thought, 'That's where I need to go.'"

Abby's conversion made news nationwide. And despite criticism and a lawsuit from pro-abortion forces, she remains an articulate voice for all abused by the abortion industry. In times when hope and truth are badly needed, Abby's "Yes" to God's call to live for Him inspires us all.

the mother's breast tissue, making it cancer resistant. This is why full-time pregnancy exerts a protective effect. Pregnancies ending two months or more early leave the breasts only partially mature with more places for cancers to start. Such premature births more than double the breast cancer risks. Early miscarriages, however, do not because of inadequate hormones at that time. Note that in the face of clear evidence, Komen for the Cure, says absolutely nothing about this cause and effect.

**ABC STUDIES DOCUMENTED:** Dr. Gerard Nadal, a microbiologist at St. John's University in New York, plans to publish one study daily on his blog confirming the link between induced abortion and breast cancer. **ABORTIONS CAUSE MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS:** A leading group of psychologists and mental health professionals in England published a group letter in the *London Times* stating, "Research published in the *Journal of Child Psychology and Psychiatry* in January has shown that even women without past mental health problems are at risk of psychological ill effects after abortion. Women who have had abortions had twice the level of mental health problems, and three times the risk of major depressive illness, as those who had given birth or had never been pregnant."

**FIRST AMENDMENT UPHELD:** The U.S. Supreme Court upheld a Ninth Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals decision on the rights of

pro-life activists to display photos of aborted babies on the public streets in California. The case involved the Center for Bio-Ethical Reform driving a box-body style truck through the streets displaying large photos of aborted babies. Police had detained and forbidden the display. The case was appealed by the Thomas More Law Center. This major victory reaffirms the First Amendment rights of pro-lifers to be free from unreasonable police seizures of these truthful images.

**OHIO CASE SETS LEGAL PRECEDENT:** Early October, Dominic Holt Reid pulled a gun on Yolanda Burgess, three months pregnant, and forced her to drive to an abortion center in downtown Columbus. Yolanda did not want the abortion and slipped a note to a center employee who called the police, saving her child. Now Franklin County Ohio prosecutor Ron O'Brien is going to use Ohio's fetal homicide law to obtain an attempted murder charge for this unborn child. Fetal homicide laws exist in over 35 states and have been used to obtain convictions for unlawful "termination of a pregnancy", should an unborn baby be killed, for example, in an accident. These laws have exceptions for legal abortions. This case highlights that it is illogical to recognize the humanity of an unborn child and its death in some cases, but not in abortion.

**ALASKA APPROVES PARENTAL NOTIFICATION:** After many years of controversy, the voters of Alaska were given a chance and voted 56% to establish parental notification of their daughter's intent to have an abortion for women seventeen and younger.

**OBAMACARE'S ABORTION FUNDING:** The Family Research Council has exposed, along with Senator Tom Colburn and 25 other pro-life senators, the fact that there are a dozen tax-paid abortion mandates buried in the 2,000+ page blueprint for Obamacare's socialized medicine.

**MEDICARE PARADOX:** Five hundred billion dollars is to be cut from the Federal Medicare budget at the same time it will be made to serve thirty million more people!

**FEDERAL ABSTINENCE PROGRAMS CANCELLED:** More than 176 abstinence education programs are losing funding for their outreach to young adults because Congress and the Obama Administration has cancelled all grants going to abstinence-centered programming in its Fiscal Year 2010 Budget. Some will lose their funding midway through their five-year grant award.

**ABORTION EQUALS MORE BREAST CANCER:** In the *Linacre Quarterly Journal*, Dr. Angela Lanfranchi details how 52 years of research has pointed to the fact that abortion, as well as hormonal contraceptives, can significantly increase the risk of breast cancer. In utero the baby produces hormones that mature 85% of
